About the Taste History Culinary Tours:

Experience the Cuisines, Culture, Art and History of
West Palm Beach (Various Districts), Florida;
Lake Worth & Lantana; and Delray Beach & Boynton Beach

Taste History™ travels to West Palm Beach (Various Districts) on the **first Saturday** of each month, year-round; and Lake Worth & Lantana on the **second Saturday** of each month, year-round; and travels to historic Delray Beach & Boynton Beach on the **third and fourth Saturdays** of each month, year-round at 11 am. **Private Group Tours are offered during the weekday.**

- At least four to five local and family-owned restaurants/eateries/markets will be visited for food tastings
- The food servings are samplings and tastings of the restaurants' cuisines along with food history, food culture and foodways information.
- Locally owned and family-owned restaurants/eateries are visited that are located in West Palm Beach (Various Districts); downtown Lake Worth & Lantana; and Delray Beach & Boynton Beach, Florida.
- You will meet the chefs and owners of the restaurants/eateries/markets
- International cuisines tasted may include American, Australian, Brazilian, Caribbean, French, Hungarian, Italian, Mediterranean, Mexican, New Zealand, Russian, Southern American, Soul Food, Spanish and Turkish.
- Tour travels to the downtowns and historic districts in West Palm Beach (Various Districts), Lake Worth, Lantana, Delray Beach and Boynton Beach, Florida along with visits to emerging art galleries and historic buildings. Tour guests meet emerging local artists and travel through emerging arts districts.
- The tour is narrated by a live guide and includes narrated local and regional history about historic areas, landmarks and people along the travel route of the restaurants/eateries.
- The tour is a combination of bus riding and four to six blocks of walking. And, some eating experiences are standing-only. The tour guests eat and then keep moving to the next site for more food, art and history.
- In addition to the walking, an air-conditioned bus is provided for the tour

- Tour is four-hours and departs promptly at 11 am. Tour starts and ends at Macy's Boynton Beach, Florida. For private group tours, door-to-door service is available - the bus can come to you for the pick-up and the return after the tour. Additional fees apply for this service.
- Tour takes place Rain or Shine
- For private group tours, the capacity is minimum 15 people/maximum 25 people
